- Mt. Holyoke Admissions Policy
 - Mount Holyoke College's policy on the admission of transgender students states that it welcomes applications for its undergraduate program from any qualified student who is female or identifies as a woman. Can you clarify "who is female or identifies as a woman"?⁴
 - The following academically qualified students can apply for admission consideration:
 - Biologically born female; identifies as a woman
 - Biologically born female; identifies as a man
 - Biologically born female; identifies as other/they/ze
 - Biologically born female; does not identify as either woman or man
 - Biologically born male; identifies as woman
 - Biologically born male; identifies as other/they/ze and when "other/they" identity includes woman
 - Biologically born with both male and female anatomy (Intersex);
 identifies as a woman
 - The following academically qualified students cannot apply for admission consideration:
 - Biologically born male; identifies as man

<u>Definitions & Terminology:</u>

Unders	standing the lingo:
0	: male or female according to chromosomes, external/internal physiology (anatomy)
0	: the psychological, social, and cultural manifestations of maleness and femaleness (masculinity and femininity)
0	: how a person perceives or experiences themselves as male/female (how they understand themselves)
0	: someone whose gender identity is the same as the sex they were assigned at birth

	 Dr. Colin Ross⁶: Gender identity disorder is unique among all DSM-IV-TR diagnoses. It is the only disorder in which treatment is designed to, reinforce, and validate the belief that is the basis of the mental disorder.
	• Dr. Colin Ross ⁷ : If a woman told a psychiatrist that she was a
	gorilla, this would be classified as a 'bizarre delusion' according to
	the text for schizophrenia. If she said she was the last Neanderthal
	left on earth, this also would be a bizarre delusion. But if she tells
	him she is a man trapped in a female body, the psychiatrist agrees
	to have her body fixed.
0	: broad umbrella term for a person who experience a different gender identity than their biological sex
0	: those whose birth at sex is somewhat ambiguous; 1 in every 5,000 births (0.02%)

- Statistics on gender dysphoria:
 - o Mark Yarhouse⁸: It's _____ a very common experience.
 - o 2011 UCLA study
 - o 2016 UCLA study
- Gender dysphoria in children:
 - "No one knows for sure. Researchers have not figured out how to obtain consistent, reliable answers from teenagers, much less younger children. The best estimates are that the population is small, probably under 1 percent of adolescents."9
 - o **Dr. Paul S. McHugh** further noted studies of children who had expressed transgender feelings but for whom, over time, 70%-80% "spontaneously lost those feelings."¹⁰

- Western Sydney University professor of pediatrics, Dr. John Whitehall said a study of Dutch children with dysphoria aged 4-11 revealed 52% had associated psychiatric problems with diagnoses including anxiety, phobias, mood disorders, depression, attention deficit disorder and oppositional behavior.¹¹
- American College of Pediatricians: Young children are being permanently sterilised and surgically maimed under the guise of treating a condition that would otherwise resolve in over 80% of them. This is criminal.¹²
- "The American College of Pediatricians urges educators and legislators to reject all policies that condition children to accept as normal a life of chemical and surgical impersonation of the opposite sex. Facts not ideology determine reality."

- Know the goal of the conversation
 - Mark Yarhouse²¹: "The tip of the iceberg may be gender atypicality 'Use this pronoun,' or, 'Call me this.' Many times ministers respond to what's above the surface of the iceberg. What's under the surface of the iceberg is much more substantive, and that is a need for _________, a need to be loved, a need for identity, compassion, spiritual questions ('Does God love me? Does God like me? Do you want me here?'). A lot of churches, in my view, are at their best when they minister to what's under the surface, and not overreact to what's above the waters.

 Be there when their sense of identity is not fulfilled through whatever nonbiblical ways they've pursued it
